Summary of Contents:	One poster with the wording "Centenary. Sir Isaac Brock, "the hero of Upper Canada" who was unfortunately killed in action at the Battle of Queenston Heights on the Niagara River, October 13, 1812. Sir Isaac was only in his 44 th year.
