<b>Summary of Contents:</b>	<p>The collection consists of photocopied postcards from areas in the Niagara region. The collection was arranged into four series:</p> <p><b>Series I: Jordan, 1920-1930, 1964, n.d.</b></p> <p><b>1.1</b> Contains 25 copies of postcards. Postcards include the Dwarf Village Inn; Jordan Harbour; Hannigan's Tourist Camp; a bakery; the canning factory; Jordan Valley campground; Main Street; G.T. Railway Bridge crossing the Twenty; Jordan Harbour Park; railway station; and Rittenhouse School.</p> <p><b>Series II: Merritton, 1910-1917, n.d.</b></p> <p><b>1.2</b> Contains 14 copies of postcards. Postcards include the Fire Department's famous drill corps; Wilson Carbide Works; Canada Wheel Works; Main Street; bird's eye view of Merritton; Niagara, St. C. &amp; T.R. Station; Local and Main Line cars at N.S. &amp; T. Station; G.T.R. Station; Independent Rubber Company Factory; and the Grand Trunk Railway System on the Welland Canal. Also contains some photocopied news clippings about train accidents in Merritton.</p> <p><b>Series III: Stamford, n.d.</b></p> <p><b>1.3</b> Contains 3 copies of postcards. Postcards include the Queen's Hotel, and Uncle Tom's Cabins at Stamford Centre.</p> <p><b>Series IV: Thorold, 1854, 1876, 1908-1948, n.d.</b></p> <p><b>1.4</b> Contains 46 copies of postcards. Postcards include the Fire Hall; N.S. &amp; T. Car Station; Niagara, St. Catharines and Toronto Railway Bridge over the new Welland Canal; the Beaver Board Co.; Front Street; New Grand Trunk Railway Depot; Ontario Paper Mill; Montrose Paper Mill; Coniagas Smelter; the Roe Mac Plant and Foley Reiger Pulp Mill; Welland Canal twin locks; the old Welland Canal and Penman's Knitting Mill; Lock 24 on old Welland Canal showing Montrose Paper Mill, Fire Hall and Flour Mill; A. McClenchy flour, feed, field &amp; garden seeds; the Thorold Pulp Co. Ltd.; Niagara Central swing bridge over new Welland Canal; Steamers in flight locks; transformer station; Post Office; Thorold band; S.S. Prince Rupert entering Lock 23; and S.S. Dunelm leaving Lock 24. Also contains some photocopied news clippings about a railway accident at Thorold (1854) and a dispute between Irish and Italian canal workers (1876).</p>
