Contains several copies of a death notice containing a photo and brief profile of W.H. Cowan's career with Maple Leaf Milling.</p>

<b>Administrative/ Biographical Sketch:</b>	W.H. (Harry) Cowan was the Manager of Maple Leaf Mills in Port Colborne. He was transferred to Port Colborne as Assistant Manager from the Thorold mill in 1917. He spent a year at Head Office as Traffic Manager and returned to Port Colborne in 1923. In 1929 he was appointed Manager.
