LETTER

THE SECRETARY OF WAR,

TRANSMITTING

In compliance with a resolution of the House calling for a statement of the number of officers, non-commissioned officers, privates, &c., who served for a period of six months and upwards in the war of 1812.

SIR: In compliance with the resolution of the House of Representatives of the 26th ultimo, requesting the Secretary of War to furnish "an account of the number of officers, non-commissioned officers, musicians, privates, and marines who were in the service of the government of the United States during the war with Great Britain of 1812, for a period of six months and upwards," I have the honor to transmit herewith a report of the Third Auditor, communicating the information desired, so far as it is in possession of this department.

SIR: I have the honor to return to you herewith the resolution of the House of Representatives of the 26th ultimo, on the motion of the

Hon. William Howard, which you referred to me on the 30th ultimo, for a report as to the number of officers, musicians, privates, and marines who were in the service of the government of the United States during the war with Great Britain of 1812, for a period of six months and upwards, and have to inform you that, in compliance with said resolution, a statement has been prepared in this office, having been compiled from the reports of the Third Auditor in pursuance of similar resolutions of the House of Representatives of the 29th of April, 1826, and 5th of February, 1858, which I herewith enclose.— (See Ex. Doc. No. 20, 2d session 24th Congress, and Doc. 72, 1st session 35th Congress.)

The number of marines has necessarily been omitted from my report, for the reason that the records of this office furnish no information in regard to that class of the service. Resort will therefore have to be had to the records of the office of the Fourth Auditor.
