**Acquisition Info.:** Acquisition information for the earliest records (Series I. Sub-Series A-K, 1967-1977) is unknown. Transfers of Convocation programmes and Order and Form of Convocation generally occur twice a year following Convocation ceremonies. Further accruals are expected.

**Administrative History:**

Convocation is a natural and vital function of the life of a university. As students progress through their academic career the ultimate end result is completion and in celebration of this convocation ceremonies are held. The fonds is significant because it documents the very beginning of discussions of Convocation and what that means for a young university. On May 30, 1967 the University held its first Convocation on the outdoor podium at the newly constructed DeCew campus, today known as the main campus. *The Globe and Mail*, May 31, 1967 reported the following:

*The convocation, which was held in brilliant spring sunshine, was only marred by the fact that construction is still under way on the 14-story library tower, originally scheduled to be finished last fall.*

Thirty-nine students received their degrees that day, the first being John Auld. As the University's first graduands, these students make up part of the group known as the *Silver Badgers*. The use of the outdoor podium also required planning for alternate locations when inclement weather threatened. The first Convocation was held as part of a series of events sponsored by the University to celebrate Canada's centennial. The events included a lecture, an open air concert with fireworks display and a reception and display for the friends of Brock University Library. After the construction of the physical education complex in 1973 convocation ceremonies were held indoors.

**Scope and Content:**

The fonds consists of programmes, invitations, multimedia material, correspondence and minutes maintained for and by the Office of the Registrar. These materials were used for the function of conducting convocation ceremonies. The

Convocation records in Series One retain their original folder titles with a few minor changes for clarity. Records within this series include lists, minutes, diagrams, maps and invitations. These records contain the bulk of material regarding the plans and procedures created and discussed for holding Convocation ceremonies in a variety of locations. Original folders labelled miscellaneous had their contents removed and filed with more logical materials within the sub-series. In Series One, Sub-Series L, some file folders were received without contents and some file folders became empty when order and form of convocation and convocation programs were removed, this has been so indicated next to each appropriate folder description. Series Two contains video and digital recordings of Convocation ceremonies and photographs of selected students and honorary graduands. The ceremonies recorded in VHS format are listed according to the information found on the affixed label. The photographs capture the highlights of the ceremony, but do not include official photographs of each graduand, except years 1988-1994. In Sub-Series C, Highlights of Convocation, the photographs were removed from their original hard sided album binder and placed in file folders. The title page of the album was copied to retain original information. Series Three contains the programmes and invitations made available to graduands and their guests. This series also includes the order and form of proceedings used by key individuals for conducting the Convocation ceremony. All clippings were photocopied.
