**Administrative History:**

The Niagara Region Home Economics Association (NRHEA) was founded in 1960. The group was active within the Niagara area and took part in community events, fundraisers and information sessions. The NRHEA worked with Women's Place and Nova House and they presented a yearly scholarship to a deserving student who was entering a university program in food and nutrition sciences, fashion arts or interior design.

**Scope and Content:**

This fonds consists of administrative records covering 1960 (when the association was founded) up until 2010. It contains minutes, executive membership lists, meeting notices, newsletters, correspondence, photos, memorabilia, a cd, examples of community projects and a description of the student award.
