Peach (1842-1926) was a well-known geologist whose work focused on the geological structure of Scotland, and in particular the Northwest Scottish Highlands and Southern Uplands. He formed a close working relationship with John Horne, and the two collaborated on many works, most notably two memoirs of the Geological Survey of Great Britain, <i>The Silurian Rocks of Britain</i> (1899) and <i>The Geological Structure of the North-West Highlands of Scotland</i> (1907).</p> <p>The memoirs of the Geological Survey of Great Britain published in 1907, <i>The Geological Structure of the North-West Highlands of Scotland</i> is available in the Special Collections stacks.
