The records include research, data summary forms of persons, tombstone sketches, photographs, maps, and handwritten notes. Research papers by students in Dr. Rupp's class are also included.

Administrative History:

The 19th Century Tombstone Database project received funding from the Federal Summer Youth Employment scheme in the summer of 1982 and led by Dr. David W. Rupp, Classics Department, Brock University. Students were hired to collect and record data on existing 19th century burials in various cemeteries in the Niagara region.

The data was collected and presented in the form of data summary forms of persons, tombstone sketches, photographs of tombstones, maps. Since the completion of this project in 1982 a number of the tombstones have disappeared, been vandalized or suffered environmental conditions that make them illegible. These records were donated to the Brock University Archives upon Dr. Rupp's retirement from Brock University.

Scope and Content:

The records are divided into three series, with the bulk of the records being in Series I. Cemetery records. Series I. is further subdivided into individual cemeteries. Each tombstone is represented by a file folder and the name and known death date is noted in the inventory. Not all files contain complete information. Each file may include the following materials: data summary sheet, tombstone sketch, photographs, handwritten notes. Initially some of the photographs were separated from the file folders and every attempt has been made to reunite them with the appropriate tombstone. In some cases the tombstones were in such deteriorated condition which has made this impossible.

Within Series I. the cemeteries have been grouped by township. The townships include Grantham, Louth, Niagara, Clinton, Thorold, Pelham; all are now part of the Niagara region. A Tombstone Project control number, where available is noted in the sub-series title.

Series II. Administrative Files, 1901, 1966, 1977-1979, 1982-1983, 1985-1986, 1988, n.d. contains the details of the project, research support material and the student projects created as a result of the data collection.

Series III. Maps, contains the oversized maps used as research support material.
