

Died at his residence in the Township of Clinton
on the day of September last Doct^r Cyrus
Summer -

The Doctor was a native of the State of
Connecticut - and emigrated to this Province
in the year 1802 and commenced the study of
Physic under the late Doct^r Ken at Niagara
when after completing his studies necessary to admit
him to practice he removed to Clinton where he continued
until the breaking out of the ^{late} War between the United
States and Great Britain when from the deficiency
of medical men in the army the Doctor among others
was called upon to do duty in it - in which ^{business} he continued

until the year 1813 during which as a professional
man he rendered essential services - the fatigues and
duties of which materially impaired his constitution

at the close of the War he returned to his farm where
he continued to practice until within a few weeks of
death - as a practical ~~farmer~~ agriculturist as
well as a physician this part of the country will
lose regret his loss - for his active and unceasing
efforts in the improvement of his adopted country

after a lingering illness of five months which he
bore with Christian fortitude he closed a life
useful to his country in the 60th year of his age
leaving a large family to mourn the loss of a
beloved Parent and much and justly regretted by all
who knew him - his remains were followed to

grave by a numerous and respectable body of his
friends and neighbours. Thus testifying the loss they
had sustained and the respect in which he was
