<b>Administrative/ Biographical Sketch</b>	<p>The Welland Teachers' Association held their twenty second annual convention on October 20-21, 1899 in Port Colborne. Sixty-two teachers were in attendance. The lecture and concert programme, held on Friday evening, October 20, 1899, formed the entertainment portion of the annual convention. The programme was held at Mathews' Hall, in Port Colborne, Ont. Vocal performances by Mrs. MacKelcan and Mrs. Caldwell bookended a lecture by Rev. N. [Nathanael] Burwash, D.D., L.L.D, Chancellor of Victoria University, Toronto. Rev.
