VanSomeren.</p> <p>The Dufferin and Haldimand Rifles of Canada, headquartered in Brantford, Ont. held a training camp for its militia members at the Niagara Camp in Niagara-on-the-Lake, Ont. in 1938 and 1939. The Haldimand Rifles of Canada and The Dufferin Rifles of Canada amalgamated in 1936 to form The Dufferin and Haldimand Rifles of Canada. This militia went on to serve at home and abroad during World War II.</p>
