Administrative/ Biographical Sketch	The Niagara District Mutual Fire Insurance Company was established in 1836. By 1876 it was the oldest mutual insurance company in Canada, with Dr. Theophilus Mack as president and Henry Martin Giles the secretary-treasurer. The papers include an application form, a premium note and three premium receipts to be issued to clients by company officials printed for the 1850s. The receipts bear the watermark "F.A. Gordon 1854". All items are blanks. The application form was printed at the office of the Semi-Weekly Post in St. Catharines.
