Joseph Burger and his wife Annie Rowland were natives of New Jersey and arrived in the Niagara Region at an early date, settling in Thorold Township. Both were United Empire Loyalists. The smaller of the two documents is a note in pencil about the McDonaugh property located at an unknown location in Thorold Township.</p>
