<b>Administrative/ Biographical Sketch</b>	<p>Robert M. Disher (1900-2002), son of Merritt Vincent and Katherine Disher, received his early education in Ridgeway, Ont. and graduated from Queen's University in 1921. In 1923 he married his high school sweetheart, Gladys Medlar. Together the couple raised five children, three daughters and two sons. Robert M. Disher lived on Ridge Road in Ridgeway, Ontario when he wrote his annual Christmas letter addressed to Doris and Cliff in 1986. Disher was the author of three books, <i>Bertie Town Hall story</i>, <i>History of Ridgeway Memorial United Church and the Point Abino</i>, <i>Bertie, Ridgeway community</i> and <i>Robbie, his village, his love, his life</i>. Mr. Disher lived most of his life in Ridgeway, Ontario, he was a printer, teacher and principal, retiring in 1962. In 1988 Mr. Disher moved to Saint John, NB where died at the age of 102 in February 2002.</p>
