Administrative/ Biographical Sketch	<p>The leaflet describes for customers the procedures to successfully transplant and care for nursery stock purchased from the Pelham Nursery Co. in Pelham, Welland County. The leaflet also describes care to be given to peach trees, evergreens, perpetual clematis, asparagus, grapevines and more.</p> <p>The Pelham Nursery Company's nursery facilities were located in Pelham with offices in Toronto. It is unknown when the company began or when it ceased operations, it was still marketing nursery stock in the 1950s. At one point, the Pelham area was home to many nurseries due to its excellent soil quality and favourable growing conditions.</p>
